    - Discussed renovation of club; important to support

    - Discussion over pros/cons of holding at Bellport
      - Atmosphere: not on water & can't dingy in (understandable for Blast but concluded ok for December)

    - Thank you for coming out and supporting the Salty Dogs at Mary Dowling's on Saturday, 02/02/19. Rebooked at Mary Dowling's for 6/15/19 ☺
    - Question posed: Is it desired they play at the Spring Party? People are catching up after the winter, yearbooks are being distributed, and the layout of the BSYC makes it difficult to (a) be background music for whole group or (b) allow people to talk in the room band is playing (too loud so members can hear music in other rooms). Conclusion: to avoid playing to an empty room again, will skip performing for the 2019 Spring party & will attend/enjoy as members ☺. Will still perform for the Blast and Boatyard parties.

- Update on by-law modification review:
  - Reviewed Sailboat US Sailing class rules and noted sport boats were able to race without lifelines and heads. As this seems to be the new trend in ownership, made this modification in the hopes to increase interest and attract new racers.
  - Re: Should past & current commodores pay dues? Possibly if not honorary lifetime members (no dues), allow Sr. membership fees for life. Investigated other YCs, etc., and found mixed practices. Some yes continuous, some no while current but resumes paying after fulfilled term, some lifetime no dues beginning while current. Discussion ensued.
  - Jay Pizer spoke at meeting and clarified via e-mail: In the bylaws the senior and associate memberships are locked in at 50% of what a regular membership costs. I was proposing removing this from the bylaws so that the board would have discretion of setting the rates independently, so that regular membership and associate membership could be raised as seen fit and senior could even be left as it was. I also would like to see senior membership to be redefined in a simpler and clearer fashion, for inactive members, who no longer sail and perhaps active members with financial hardship due to being on a fixed income etc. (Both types of senior members would have to meet criteria for being in the club for a certain amount of time.)
  - No vote motioned, so no conclusion reached.

27. **Report of the Commodore:** Roger Daisley:

- Introduced discussion of raising dues for 2020.
  - Discussion ensued and covered topics of last time dues raised (2007) and if adjusted for inflation every year should be approx. \$165 by now. Suggested raising to \$150 for 2020, with incentives such as if pay by 12/31 only pay \$135; by due date starting 1/1/20, \$100 and will incur a \$5 late fee by 1/31/20, another \$5 (affectively \$10 total) if paid by 2/27/20, and another \$5 (\$15 total) by 3/31. If not paid by April 1<sup>st</sup>, you are on the "Not in Good Standing" list. Some members mentioned that would lead to difficult bookkeeping.
  - More discussion re: when raised dues in 2007, was more money lost from leaving over increase than due to average decrease in membership? Jeff gave loss data from last 5 years, however, members did not stipulate why leaving, nor was asked for feedback. Reason for members leaving in 2007 was not available either so don't know if it was for reasons other than dues increase.

**New Business:** Directory: After discussion on how to proceed with directory, it was decided to use pictures from 2018 Holiday Party (many thanks go out to Rich Tesoro for donating his time during party to take pictures and many hours after to sort and match pictures to names and to Mara Liesegang, Nikki Tedesco and Jaxson for helping make sure all attending members were photographed) & the 2019 Spring Party to make the directory. The directory will include each members' name, picture, & boat name. Any other information (i.e. address, phone number) can be referenced in the yearbook. The completed directory will be converted into a PDF file and e-mailed to all members. This eliminates the need to post on-line, password protecting, and increasing the amount of personal information shared over the internet. For those who didn't / don't attend the Holiday nor Spring Parties, their information will either not be included, or (hopefully only a few) contact can be attempted to acquire a picture. Those members who don't wish to be included can request not to be photographed / included.
