Installing/Configuring Pro Dada

Required: Set the Pro Dada Cronjob

This cronjob makes sure that things like the Mailing Monitor, Scheduled Mass Mailing, Bounce Handler, and Bridge function properly:

```
http://newstest.sbccsail.org/dada/mail.cgi/_schedules/_all/_all/_silent/
```

Set this URL to be fetched by a scheduled task (cronjob) on a recurring schedule (~5 minutes)

Using the curl command:

```
/bin/curl --user-agent "Mozilla/5.0 (compatible;)" --silent --get --url http://newstest.sbccsail.org/dada/mail.cgi
```

Required: Move the, "installer" directory
